Clerk's Report for November 23, 2021

Our meeting was called to order a few minutes after 7:00 pm by Ron Marsh. We had 24 persons in attendance.

Bill Humenczuk gave a brief financial report and a brief summary of the 2021 years expenses and income. In total we "deficient" spent for the year, mainly due to the cost of the "Make and Take" to Turkey Creek.

Larry Diehl gave a summary presentation on the upcoming August 6, 2022 Turkey Creek Division Annual Meet. He said we are on track to send "notices" to vendors for the Train Show. All in all, expenses for the space, tables and plaques have increased. He has increased table rentals and gate admission, but we can expect to lose about \$1,000 for 2022. In 2023, we will again have to increase rates, to achieve a break even status, but we should not scare off the vendors for this year.

Larry acknowledged George Prock who has donated several items for members to have and special attention to two switch lanterns, we plan to use a "Best of Show" model awards 2022 and 2023! Thank you very much, George.

Mark Juett gave a detailed review of wiring a layout for DCC. He reviewed areas of concern, like where to run bus wires, sizes of wires, paying attention to voltage drop, break the layout into power districts, etc. A good overview of details that must be considered.

Miles Hale discussed his work in creating a section of the KC West Bottoms, 12th Street Viaduct. He reviewed details of the 3D printing to allow him to install lights and support the model.






Ross Moody's brother:

It was reported at our November 23rd meeting, that Ross Moody recently lost his brother to cancer. Our condolences go to Ross and his family.



Thank you George!


We are keeping two RR Switch Lanterns and will use each as model contest "Best of Show" Awards, 2022 and 2023.




